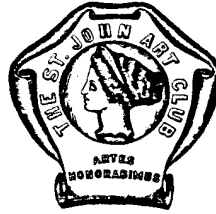

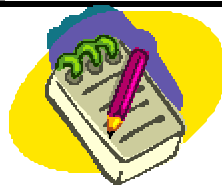

Invitations can be sent by email and it is planned to make one available to the entrants to be forwarded to friends and relatives whom you wish to invite.

It is your responsibility to invite friends and interested art enthusiasts to this event.

The cut-off date will be December 17th.

It is important that the deadlines are met so that all preparations can be completed.

All paintings must arrive at the Gallery on or before that day.

Please label your painting (on the back) clearly with the title, medium, size and price if for sale.

If not for sale please mark NFS.

The paintings will be hung on Friday, January 13th and the opening reception will be on Sunday the 15th from 2pm-4pm

Please keep this reminder handy for reference.

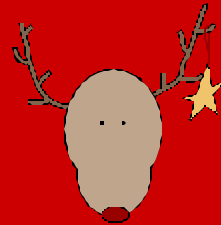

- Hang at own risk



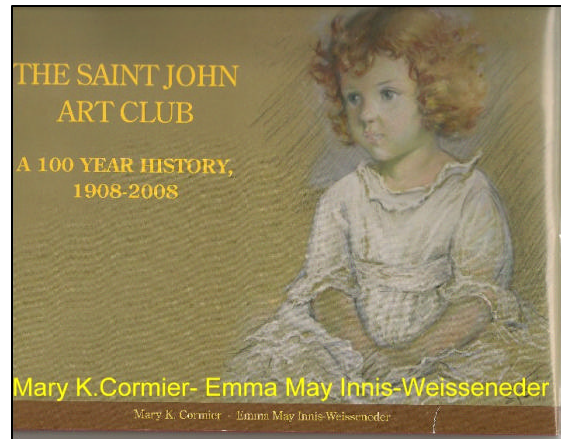
Change Day for paintings will be on the last Saturday of month, Nov. 26th.

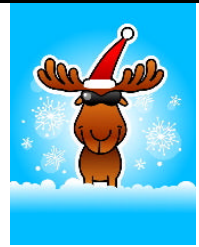
